Tracks4Africa 21.06 Release Notes

01 June 2021

Note: This is a subscription release. If you have purchased a yearly or 5-yearly subscription, this will be a map upgrade for your active subscription.

The map growth is organic in nature. This release will include more roads, tracks and waypoints in general.

What is new on the T4A GPS Maps Subscription release 2106?

To date our Map Coverage includes:

- Most complete and detailed protected areas (national parks, game reserves, private nature reserves etc.) in Africa – 2 580 parks in total.
- 17 207 accommodation listings.
- 4 406 camp sites, the most complete camping data base in Africa.
- 7 645 places to eat or drink.
- 14 581 fuel stops.

Change log from selected data submissions:

We are in the process of creating a new road atlas for Southern Africa. In the process we have also been researching Eastern Africa.

Whenever our team works on such a project you can expect a lot of map clean-up and standardization to happen. We identify areas where we need to clean up or add data. Our POI content team is also working through this entire region to bring new POI into the database, mapping services per town. You will see in the data stats that we had significant POI growth in Eastern Africa as well, and in particular with regards to accommodation and food & drink categories. We have gain been assisting with fuel stop surveys which resulted in a 10.7% growth in our fuel stop category.
